Ghamma		<p>G (as in Good)</p> <p>Gh Ġ (as in Oghnia (Arabic: Song))</p> <p>NG (as in Angel)</p>	<p><i>ΑΓΙΟΣ</i> (A-gios = Holy)</p> <p><i>Γαβριηλ</i> (Ghav-riel = Gabiel)</p> <p><i>Αγγελος</i> (Angelos = Angel)</p>	

*Ghamma is normally pronounced G as in*  
*Ἁγιος (A-gios = Holy)*

*It is pronounced GH as in* *Σαβριηλ* *(Ghav-*  
*riel = Gabiel) (arabic letter Ghen) if followed*  
*by any of the vowels: α.ε.ι.η.υ*



*It is pronounced NG as in* *ἄγγελος* *(Angelos*  
*= Angel) If there are two consecutive ττ the*  
*first is pronounced N, and the second is G*

<i>Delta</i>		<i>TH (as in Then) D (as in David)</i>	<i>Δωρον</i> (Ztho- roon = gift)	

*Delta is normally pronounced TH  
as in Δωρον (Ztho-roon = gift)*

*It is pronounced D in a person's name as  
in Δαν (Dan = Dan)*

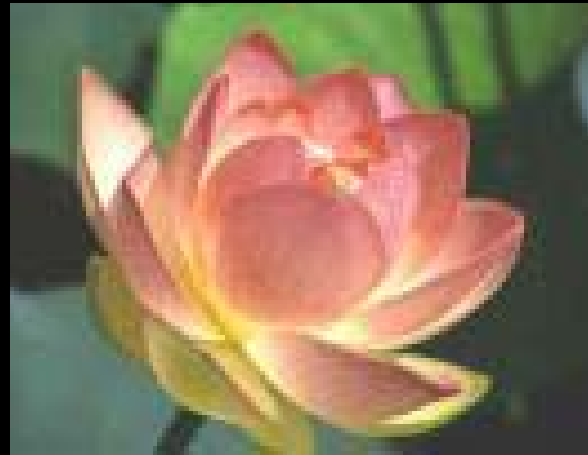
