The work of prayer belongs to the angels, and is, therefore, the special concern of the Church. Every other work, i.e., charity, nursing the brethren, visiting the sick, caring for prisoners, releasing captives, and other similar things, is done by the brethren in love and offered by them to God. Pashons

- Named after Khonso, the god of the moon, on of the Thebic trinity and the son of Amoun-Ru and Mout.
- Gregorian calendar equivalent: May 9 to June 7.
