- Gregorian Calendar equivalent: September 6-10.

Thoout

- Named after the god Tegot, Tut or Tuhout, who is the god of wisdom, science, art inventions and divine mysteries for the Egyptians.
- Gregorian Calendar equivalent: September 11 to October 10.
